#### Course summary

Partnership for 21st Century Skills (P21) promotes integration of key skills when teaching core subjects such e.g. language and reading, arts, mathematics, economics and science. There are eight components: Critical thinking, Communication skills, Creativity, Problem solving, Perseverance, Collaboration, Information literacy, and Technology skills and Digital literacy. EFL teachers trim this list to suit their needs and mainly focus on the 4Cs: Communication, Critical Thinking, Creativity and Collaboration. The course offers a hands-on approach on how to implement the 4Cs and how and when, if possible, incorporate the other 4 components. Additionally, a key component of 21st century skills is Mediation as defined by CEFR which underpins many of the skills.
